Assembly 1218 100 Year Anniversary Mass

We celebrated our Anniversary Mass, with wives, Oct. 1st, at OLQOH's 4:00 pm Mass. The intentions for the Mass were the living and deceased members of Assembly 1218. 15 Honor Guard attended.

Four Priests and two Deacons with Wives attended. A total of 44 were served a delicious meal of beef and chicken. The menu was changed due to a lack of processed turkeys.

The Father Stashek Memorial Fund was terminated. Future Support for Catholic Education will come from the Council General fund.

After our chaplain, Father George Stashek, passed away, the Council established a memorial fund, in his name, to support Catholic education. Monies to support the Fund were to come from Chili Feeds and raffles. The first raffle was held in the summer/fall of 2004, followed by the first chili feed in October. Raffle winners were announced at the chili feed. This was repeated annually for years 2005 to 2010. Years 2011 to 2016, only the chili feed took place. Donations to catholic education, mainly to CCD programs, were made 2004-2019. A total of \$17,100.00 was donated.

Principle Chairmen initially were Joe Huser and Bill Plante. Together, they managed the chili feeds. Joe was in charge of the account at the credit union and did the cost accounting. Many KCs, however, helped. At some point, Jeff Joosten and Len Schliesman took over.

In 2022, the Council gave \$2,100.00 to CCD programs from the general fund.
